Harry joined our congregation on Nov. 25 from St. Mark's UMC in Brandon. His family joined him for this special day. Harry works in the insurance


business and is a color commentator for the University of Mississippi's football program. He was an All-American football player at the university.



Notes from the Past

Bishop Mack Stokes, named our Bishop in July 1972, was our speaker on November 26, 1972.
